Scotland Reformation Tour with 20schemes



"I am excited to introduce you to Scotland, a land that has great natural beauty, a vibrant culture, and a rich Christian heritage. Scotland was once known as the land of the book. We will visit sites that were pivotal to the Scottish reformation which unleashed a gospel resurgence in Scotland. Come and experience the sites and sounds of the nation that gave us John Knox,

David Livingstone, and Eric Liddell. But also come face to face with modern Scotland. A bold, confident, and yet spiritually dark land. Very few in Scotland have a personal relationship with Jesus today and this is especially true in Scotland's poorest communities. We will meet with church planters who are seeking to build healthy gospel preaching churches. Come and hear their stories, pray with them, and be part of what God is doing in Scotland today."

Day 1: Friday, September 14, 2018: Departure
We will depart from the USA today on our international flights to Edinburgh, Scotland. (IF)

Day 2: Saturday, September 15, 2018: Edinburgh
On arrival in Edinburgh, we will meet our Scottish tour director and board our air-conditioned bus. We will begin our time in Scotland with a bus orientation tour of Edinburgh, viewing the sites that we will see in more detail during the tour. We will then check-in to our hotel and the afternoon is at leisure to explore. We will then have dinner with invited guests who will share about their church planting in Edinburgh. (IF/D)



Day 3: Sunday, September 16, 2018: Edinburgh
We will worship at Charlotte Chapel at 10:30 AM this morning, which is less than 10 minutes' walk from our hotel. We will then have lunch with invited guests who will share about their church planting in Edinburgh. In the afternoon we will tour of Edinburgh Castle, including seeing the oldest Crown Jewels in the British Isles. The Crown, Sceptre and Sword of State were first used together for the coronation of Mary Queen of Scots in 1543. We will dine in a local restaurant this evening. (B/L/D)

Day 4: Monday, September 17, 2018: Edinburgh, Glasgow

After a relaxed breakfast, our local guide will take us on a Reformation-themed walking tour including the John Knox House, Greyfriar's Church, Magdalene Chapel and the Royal Mile. Our guide will tell us about the Reformation in Edinburgh, including John Knox, and the Covenanters. We will also visit the royal palace of Holyrood where in 1561 John Knox had discussions about Christianity with Mary Queen of Scots. We will transfer to our hotel in Glasgow this evening and dine in our hotel (B/D)

Day 5: Tuesday, September 18, 2018: Glasgow, Glencoe

After breakfast, we will drive to nearby Glasgow and have lunch with invited guests who will share about their church planting in Glasgow. In the afternoon, we will visit Glencoe, where the massacre took place on February 13, 1692. The visitor center includes a 15-minute video presentation explaining what led up to the sad events. Our hotel this evening will be in the Bridge of Orchy in the Western Highlands. Optional malt whisky tasting is available after dinner (requires pre-booking). (B/L/D)

Day 6: Wednesday, September 19, 2018: Loch Ness, Inverness, Aviemore

Today we will enjoy the Highlands of Scotland, including a one-hour cruise on Loch Ness. At the end of our cruise, we will tour Urquhart Castle. Steeped in national heritage and history, the Trossachs is home to some of the most influential and quintessentially Scottish icons of all time such as Rob Roy MacGregor and Sir Walter Scott. We will travel up to Inverness and have lunch with the church planting team there, before we continue on to Aviemore. We will enjoy some traditional Scottish food this evening in our hotel in Aviemore. (B/D)

Day 7: Thursday, September 20, 2018: Stonehaven, Aberdeen

Today's highlight will be a visit to Stonehaven, a charming harbor town just outside Aberdeen. There will be an optional hike up to Dunnottar Castle, a fabulous medieval castle located on the cliff above town. Stonehaven also has a Tolbooth museum and plenty of coffee shops. We will then continue on Aberdeen and meet with invited guests, to hear about their church planting work. We will dine in our hotel this evening. **(B/D)**



Day 8: Friday, September 21, 2018: Aberdeen, Dundee

Today is a leisure day, and options include a round of golf, a visit to a distillery, a dolphin-watching cruise, a hike, or a tour of the Aberdeen city center. We will drive to Dundee mid-afternoon and the rest of the day is at leisure. **(B)**

Day 9: Saturday, September 22, 2018: St. Andrews, Dundee

We will have a day-trip to St. Andrews, a spiritual center in Scotland for centuries. During the Reformation, St. Andrews University was third in significance after Oxford and Cambridge. In the now ruined castle, we will see the Bottle Dungeon where George Wishart was imprisoned before being burned at the stake, and




pause at his martyrdom site, also remembering fellow martyr Patrick Hamilton. St. Andrews Cathedral was once the largest church in Scotland, but fell into ruin after John Knox's sermon, which was inspired by Wishart's martyrdom. We'll see a monument to Robert the Bruce, the first king to unite the Scottish people and the wide sandy beach made famous in the film Chariots of Fire. Golfers will have the opportunity to play a round of golf, and a transfer will be arranged for them back to the hotel. Members of the church planting team will join us for dinner in our hotel in Dundee. **(B/D)**

Day 10: Sunday, September 23, 2018: Dundee, Edinburgh

The morning we will join the Lochee Baptist Chapel service, followed by a time of fellowship. We will relax in the afternoon then end the tour at the Spirit Scotland Dinner Show, with traditional Scottish music and dancing. **(B/D)**

Day 11: Monday, September 24, 2018: Return

We will transfer to the airport this morning, to return to the USA. **(B/IF)**
